Confidential outpatient therapy services are available to your student at your school district! A licensed Outpatient Clinical Therapist is placed in your schools to provide confidential therapy services to your student to assist your students in managing emotions, navigate challenges of daily life, and/or treat mental or behavioral health issues. Our therapists are here for you and your students and our priority is to help your student feel better and be successful in school and in life!

ACCESSIBILITY

Services are currently available to your student in-person, by phone or video. Should your school close down due to COVID-19 outbreak, your student's services will continue virtually. Your student's services will continue whether your student utilizes face-to-face learning, virtual learning, or hybrid.



COST

Health insurance is not required for your student to receive services, however, we do utilize it for those who have coverage. We accept Medicaid, Blue Cross and many other private insurances. No child will be refused services based on ability to pay. Sliding-scale fee is available for those who qualify.

PRIVACY

School-Based Outpatient Therapists are Licensed Mental Health Professionals. They maintain strict confidentiality for their clients. With permission, they utilize the best sources of support for the student, i.e. family, school staff, etc.
