The 1981 Seniors were represented on the Winter and Spring teams by five members. In basketball it was Joe Bleibtrey and Ernie Evans. Although regulated to a reserve role, Ernie had 29 points and 33 rebounds. He also had 2 steals from his forward position. Guard Joe had 1 point, 4 rebounds and 3 steals.

Spring found shortstop Konnie Mills hitting .424 with 19 RBI's, 26 runs and 22 stolen bases. Konnie was also named first team all conference for the fourth year in a row.

Senior baseball players did not fare as well. After a successful 1980 campaign that found him hitting .300 with 20 RBI's, leftfielder Roger Palek fell into a wicked slump. He did however lead the outfield in put-outs, with 24. He also only committed 3 errors. At the plate he hit .160 RBI's and 9 stolen bases.

Reserve outfielder Gene Oberlander also had his problems at the plate winding up with a .077 batting average. He also had 2 RBI's and scored 2 runs.
