Winning has become a tradition for the Ashley Girls' Varsity Basketball team. The 1981 girls were no exception as they finished with a perfect 10-0 MSAC record and an impressive 18-3 overall mark. The undisputed league champs certainly had a season that the Ashley Girls' Basketball followers have become accustomed to.

This year's team looked to three seniors, Lori Crumbaugh, Denise Paksi and Tammy Howes, to accept the role as team leaders. The three girls were counted on by the team to come through in clutch situations and they rarely failed. Despite the excellent statistics that the trio compiled, their leadership qualities that they displayed on the court were their most valuable assets.

The team overwhelmed most of its opponents with its tough defense and consistent offense. The Lady Bears averaged 51 points a game compared to only 32 for the opponents.

Crumbaugh led the girls with an 11 points per game and 8.4 rebounds a game average. Paksi was close behind with a 10.8 points a game average and a team leading 81 assists. Sophomore Jill Wicke turned in a super season, scoring at an 8.7 points per game clip and pulling down 7.6 rebounds a game. Howes averaged 8 points and 6.7 rebounds a game.

Crumbaugh and Paksi received all-league first team honors and Howes received all-league honorable mention.
