



The senior high and junior high school share teachers, a total of sixteen, with one common counselor. The 1982-83 school year had Mrs. Gearhart in the Art area, Mr. Hornak teaching the Business Education courses, and Mrs. Seals and Mrs. Lun-eack instructing English. A new teacher Mrs. Dyer taught the Home Economic classes, with Mr. Sches-tag over-looking the Industrial Arts curriculum. Math had Mr. Feldpausch and Mr. Hendricks expressing theory, with Mrs. Belligan and Mr. Walden training the Physical Education students. Experimenting in the Science area were two veterans Mr. Andersen and Mr. Larsen, Social Studies had Mr. Dion and Mrs. Martinez explaining past history. Mr. Sanford handled the counseling duties. Mr. Kindel teaching his last year instructed the Special Education students. The school's only principal for both elementary and high school was Mr. Wayer.

Ashley is classified as a Class D school by the State of Michigan. This classification is based on enrollment, Ashley senior high had 140 students and junior high had 96 for a total of 236 students.
