This is the fourth year in Ashley's history that there has been a Quiz Bowl Team. The 1983 Quiz Team consisted of Dennis Smith, Shirley Porubsky, Dana Chvojka, Stanley Saylor, and one alternate Wade Crumbaugh.

High School Bowl is a question-and-answer game (usually) played between two teams of four players each. There are two types of questions: Toss-ups, worth 10 points each, and Bonus, each worth a pre-stated number of points from 20-35.

Like any other game or competition there are rules and procedures to follow. The match starts with a toss up question in which either team may answer. The team that answers this question has a chance at the bonus question, then the procedure starts over with another toss up question and bonus question. The match starts with a 10 minute period of asking and answering questions, then there is a break, after the break the game goes on for another after this time period is over the team with the most points wins.

The competition for the team was two wins and two defeats:
