SCHOOL WIDE ENERGY PROJECT

The Ashley schools undertook an energy project during the 1984-85 school year. The project consisted of putting in new windows, insulating walls, and better controls on the furnaces. Davermans & Assoc. designed the construction and Engemhardt Inc. was the contractor of the \$150,000 project.

The overall goals of the project was to save energy and make the buildings more attractive. The first year's results was 1/3 less gas used, which resulted in a large money savings and more comfort in the classrooms.

The Board of Education is pleased with the results and the work of the project. The project will be paid off in ten years.
