The 1985-86 J.V. girls' basketball team had a good season. The girls had a 13-7 over-all record and tied Morrice for the league championship with an 8-2 record.

The team won eight of their last nine games, six of which were straight in a row.

There was no MVP for J.V. this year because there were too many girls to choose from to make a really fair decision. For example, Angela Felton led the team in scoring with 168 points for the season. That gave her an 8.4 average points per game. She also led the team with 80 steals. Chris Shaw averaged 5.3 points per game with 105 points, and also picked up 107 rebounds, which gave her an average 5.4 rebounds per game.

A few games really stood out from the rest. The second Dansville and Webberville games had strong fourth quarters. In each, the team scored 34 points, but with Dansville 16 of them were in the fourth quarter and with Webberville 19 of them were. The girls dominated Ithaca the second time around, with a 21 point win. At the home Byron game everything the Bears threw up went in, and they were rewarded with a 26 point victory. The last Morrice game was the most gratifying. After losing to them earlier in the season, the Bears took them by storm and defeated Morrice 39-21 on Ashley's home court.
