## Echoes Of Friendship



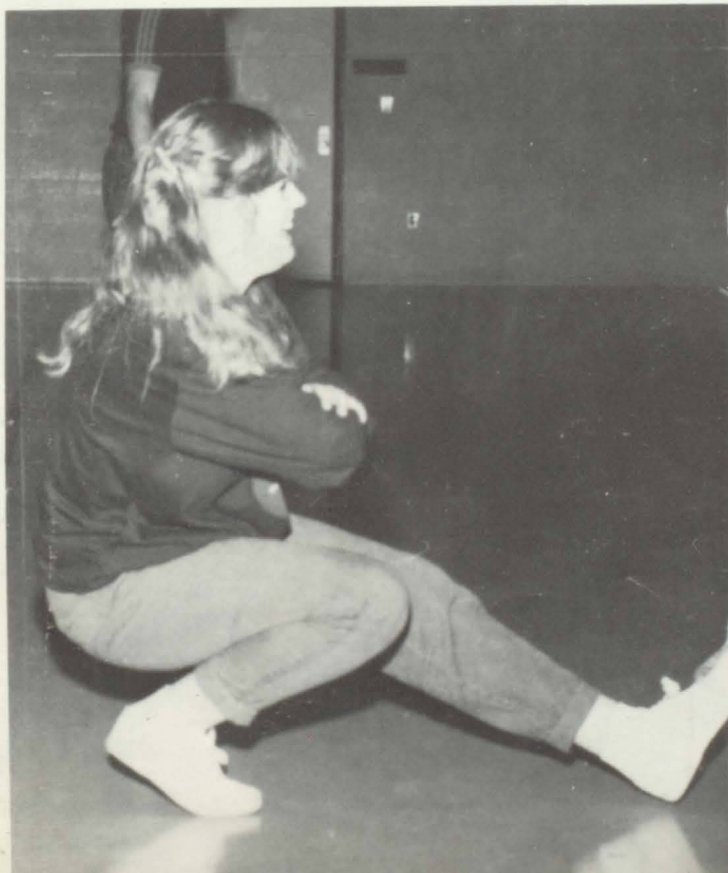
Yes, it's true, we had our share of problems and letdowns this year. But did we allow them to drag us down? No way! We picked ourselves up and pushed to make things better than they were before.
