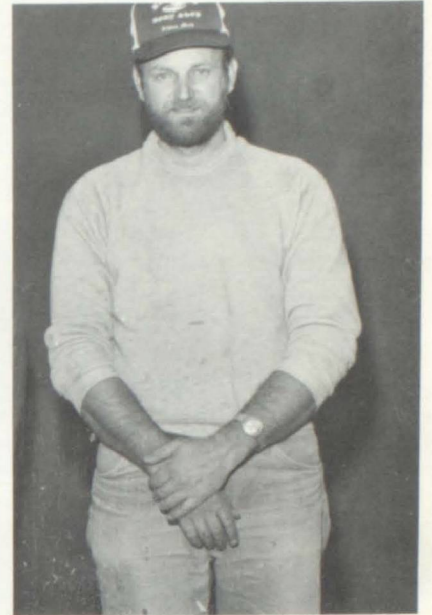


Revvin' It Up
