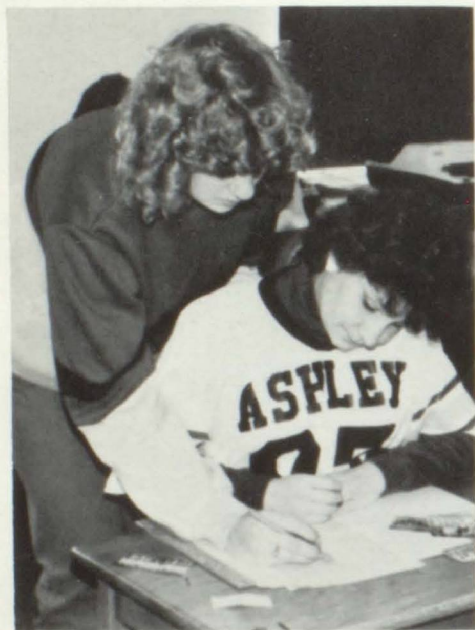


Write On . . .

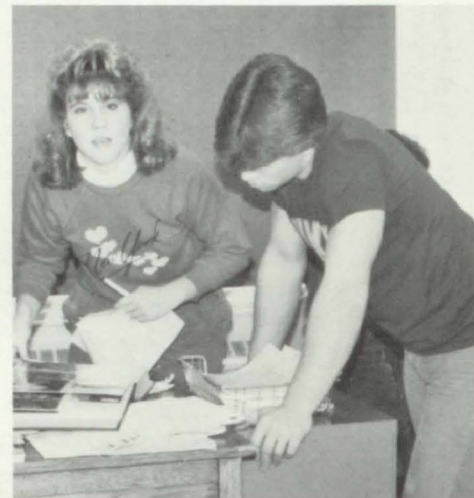
