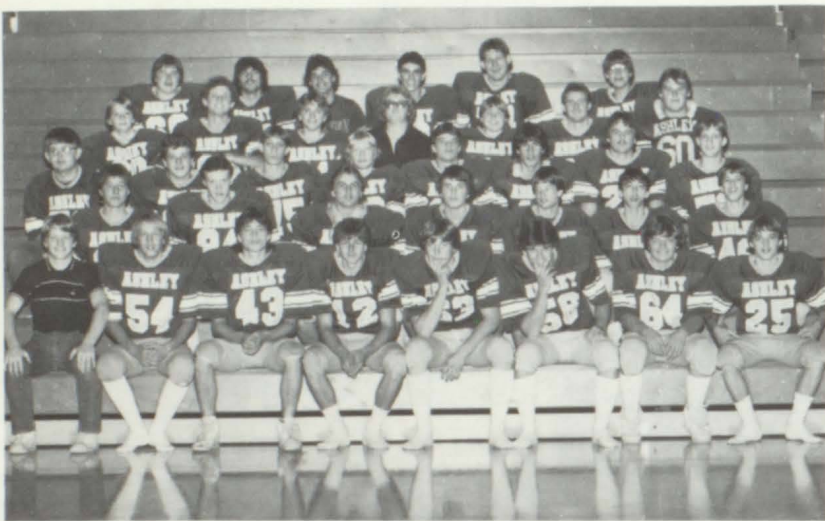


TURN IT UP
