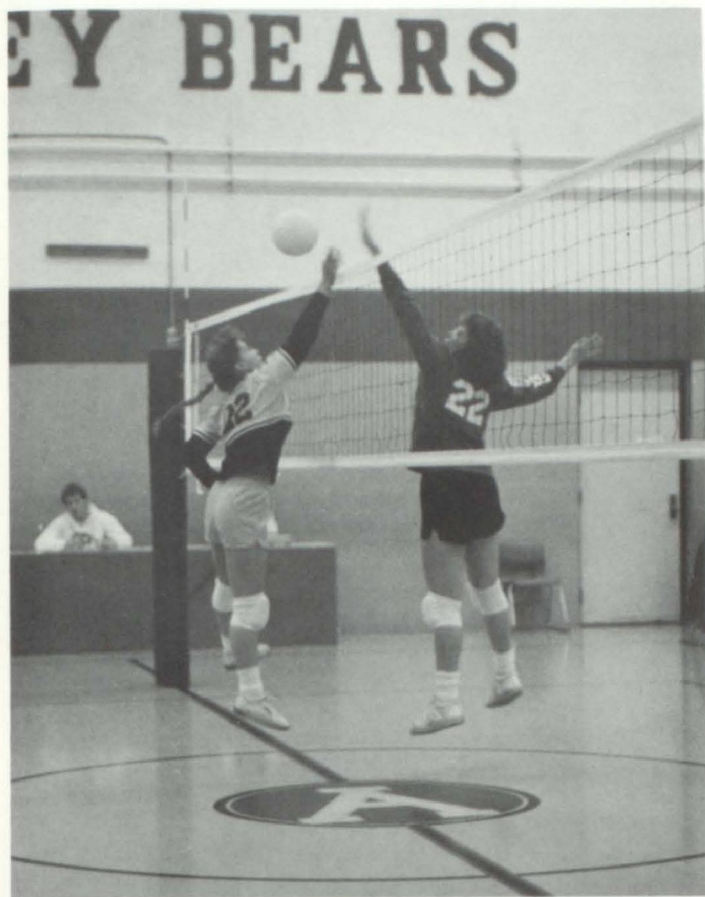


JAMIE PLESKO GOES up for a spike against Vestaburg. She led the team in spikes with 97 for the year.
