

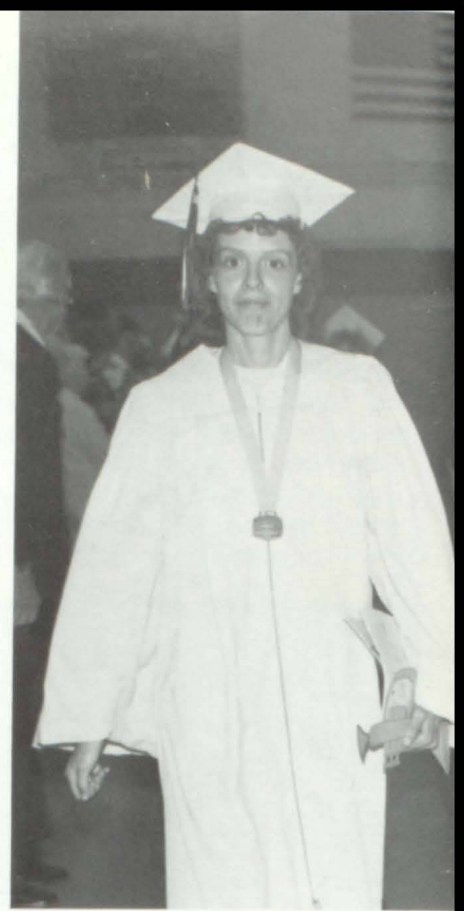
THE PRIDE AND happiness evident on the faces of Chris Shaw and Dana Payne reflect the two key emotions of graduation.
