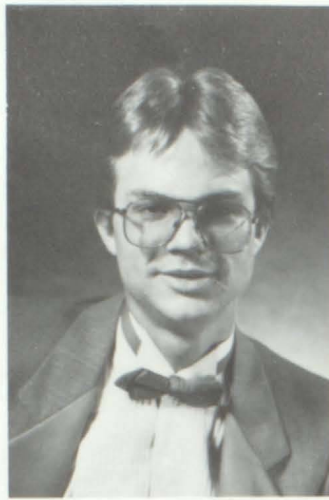
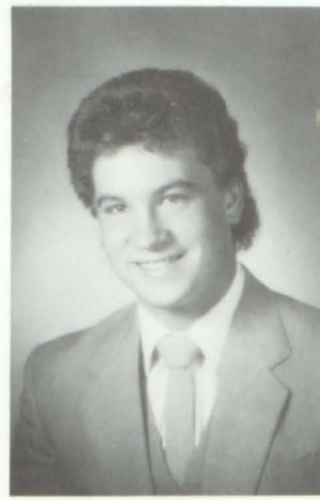




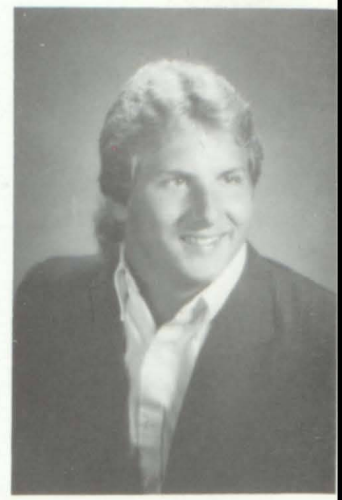

Christoph commented, "I had the time of my life. Thanks to you all."

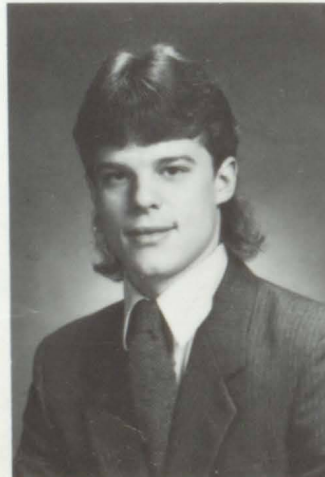
