

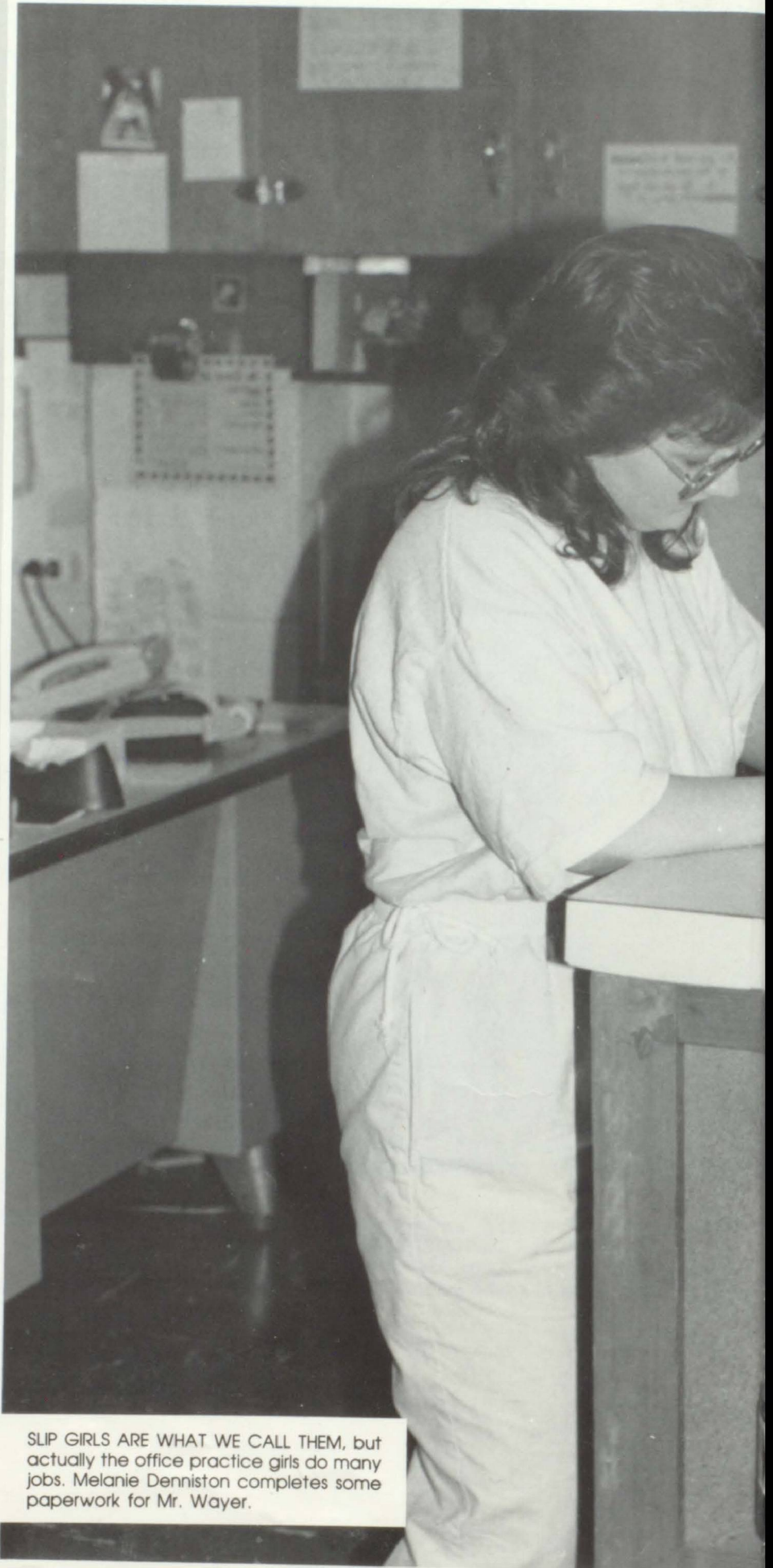
Students Who Take Cadet Teaching Sometimes Get A Surprise
