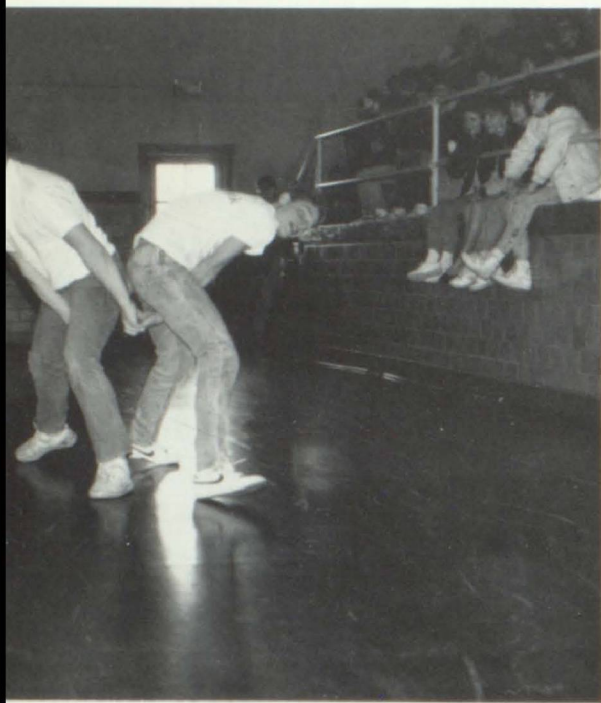


COOPERATION AND TEAM WORK help freshmen Cory Gavenda and Kevin Klatt lead their class to a victory in the relay races during Twirp Week.

## The Week Of The Twirp

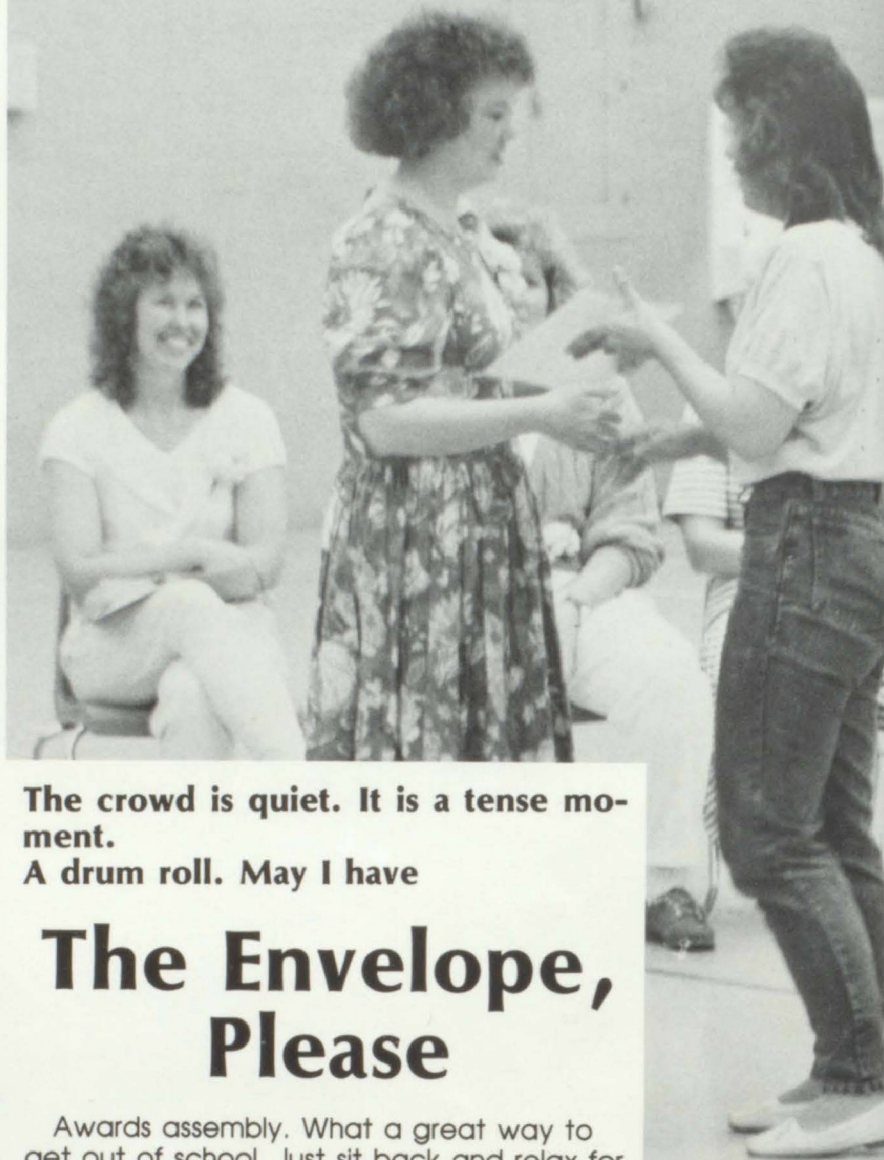
Twirp week. A great way to help those winter blahs. The time between Christmas vacation and Spring break seems to last forever. And what better cure than acting like a twirp for a week?
