# It's A Must

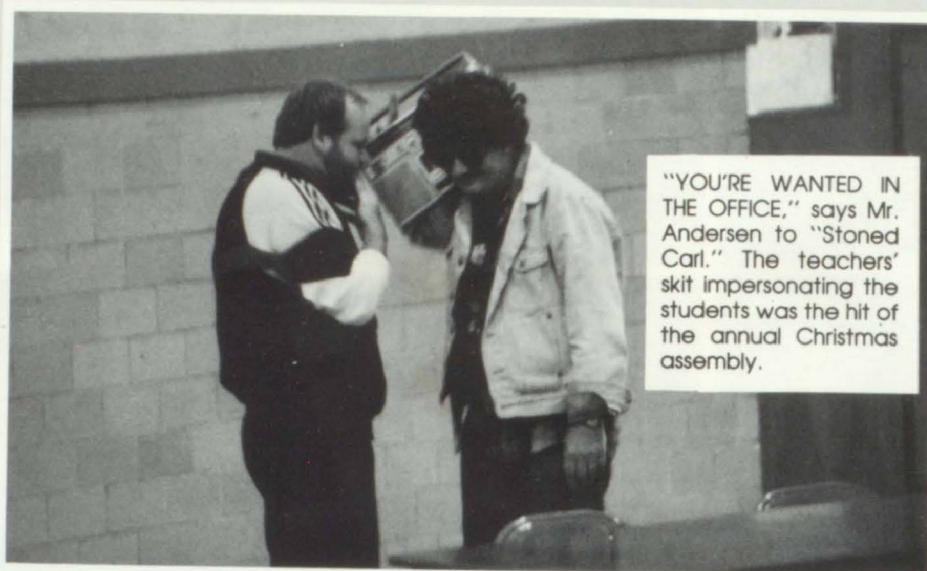
