

# WHO'S OUTRAGEOUS?

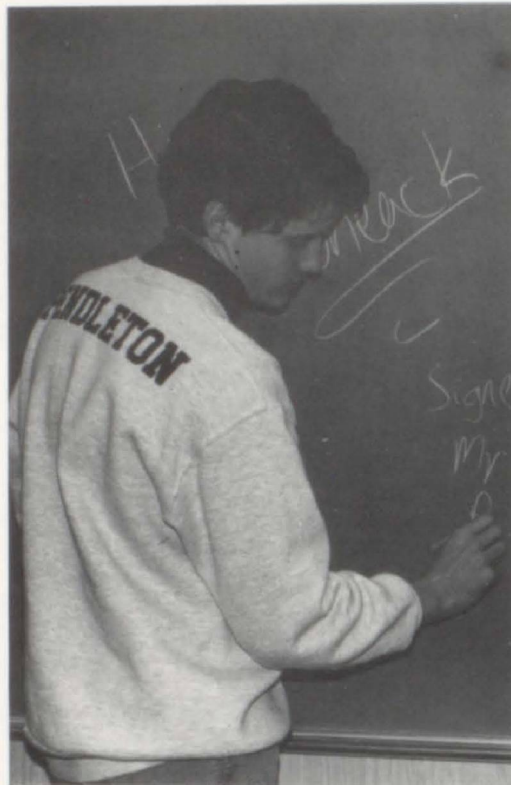
WAY COOL, MAN! Matt Miller shows off his "hippie" style during Twirp Week at the slave auction. Matt won a free pass into the dance for his outfit.
