## Never A Dull Moment!

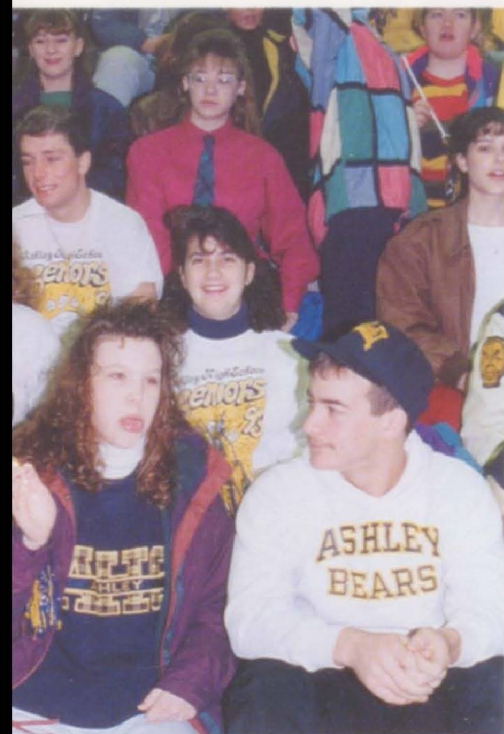
