"I like being able to keep the little kids in line," said David Polash. David spends last hour helping Miss Michelle Moore with her gym class.

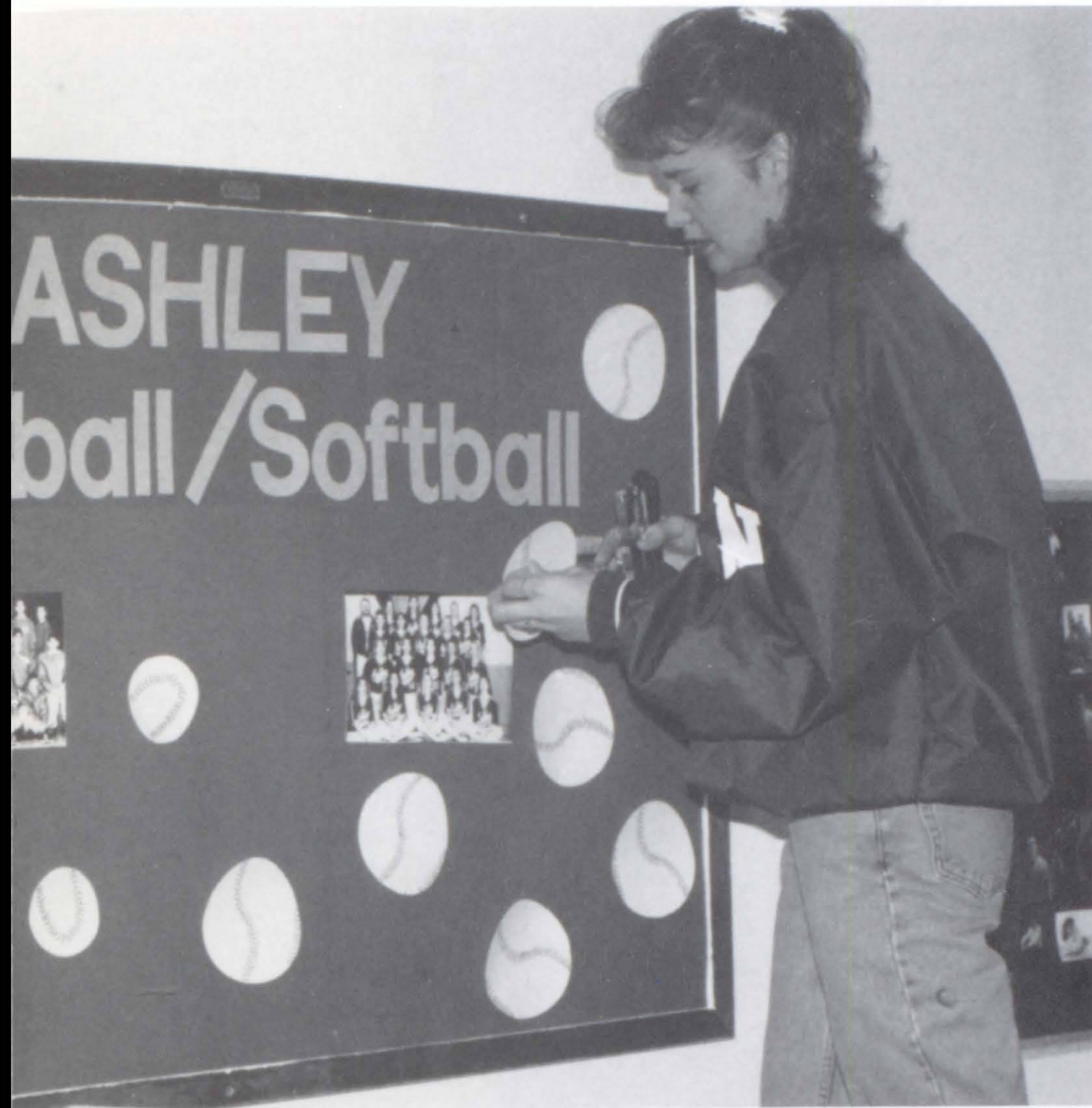
Many students take these classes instead of taking a study hall. The students get the chance to help the teachers with the little things that have to be done.
