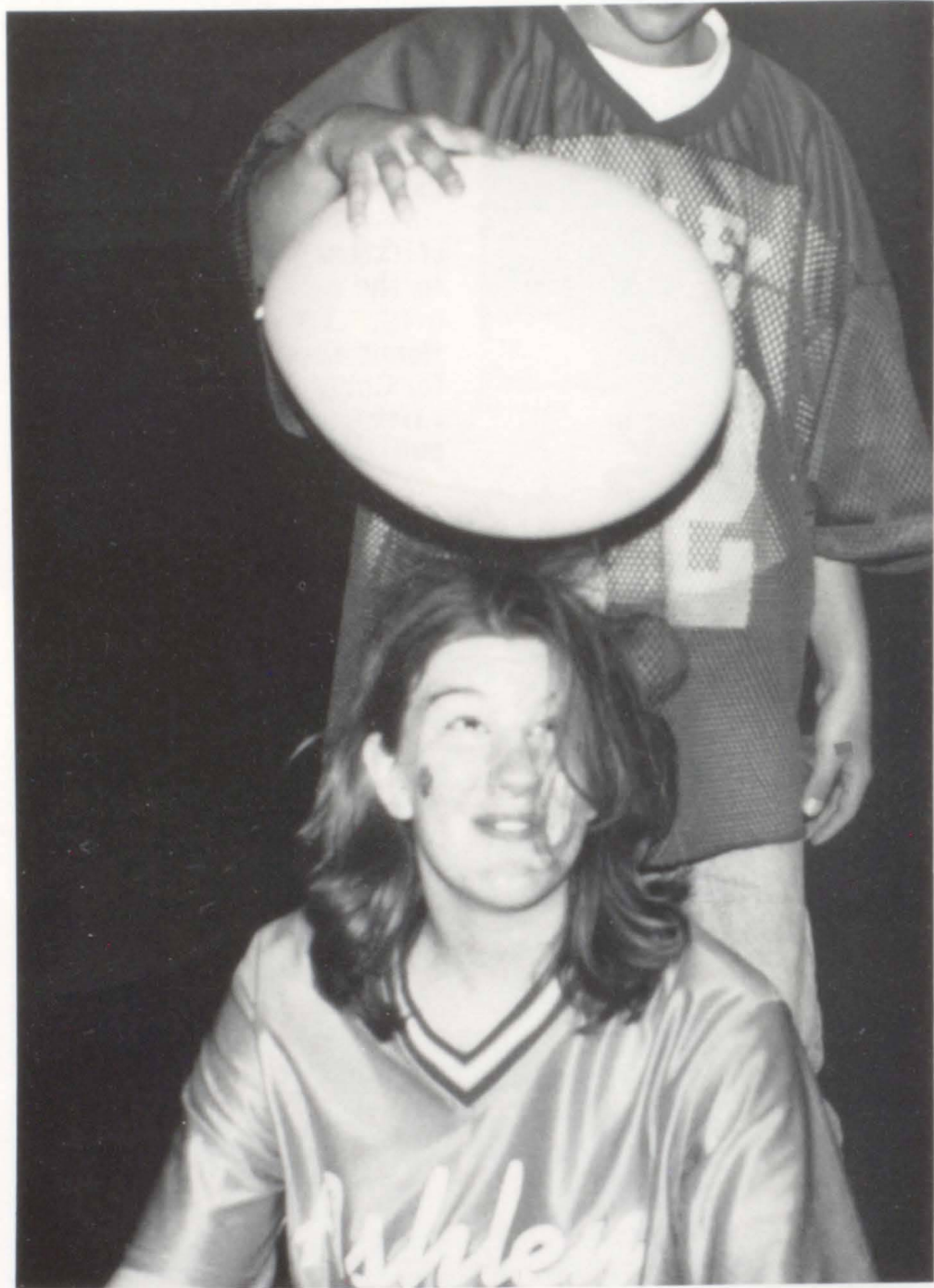
The Ashley High School Student Council is a very hardworking organization. They are the ones who make great things like Homecoming, the Christmas party, and Twirp Week, among other things, possible.
