Maybe the rest of us should sign up for those classes. After all, a little fun never hurt anyone.

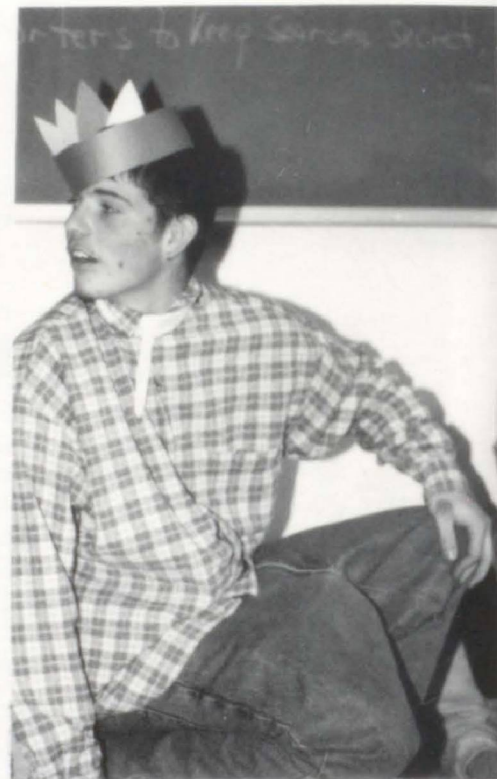
