Everyone did a fairly good job in participating. People dressed up for the dress up days, they had

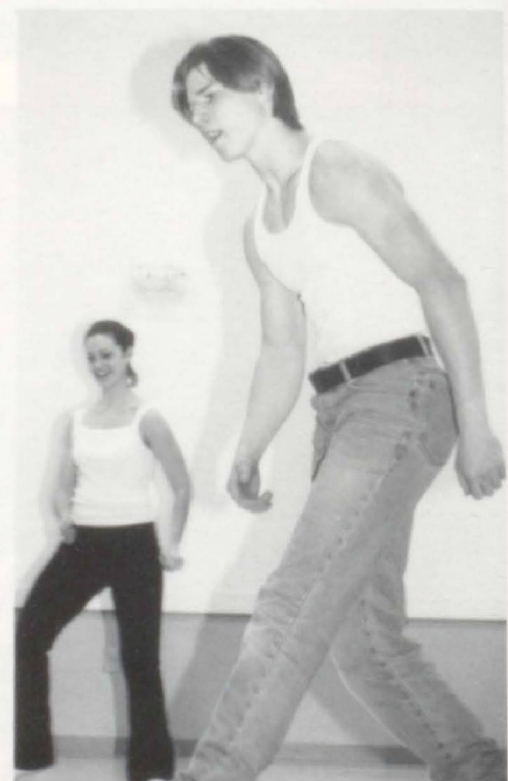
