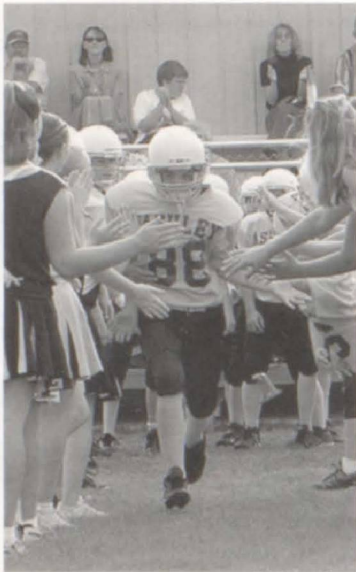
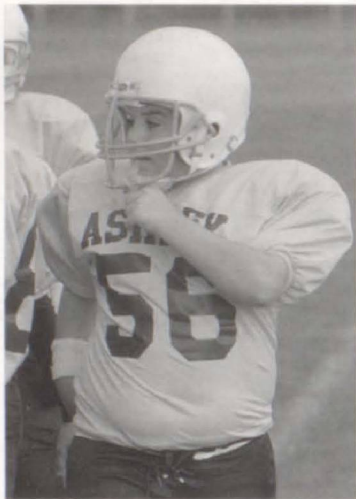


**GET HYPED** *Mike Saylor* runs through a tunnel made by the Jr. High Cheerleaders.

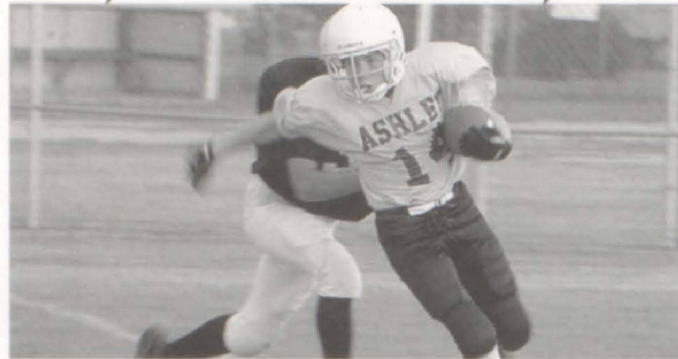

**LISTEN UP** *Patrick Searles* listens to what the coach has to say after a time out.

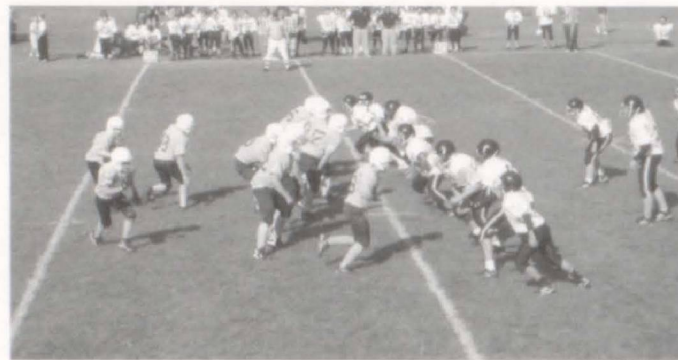
