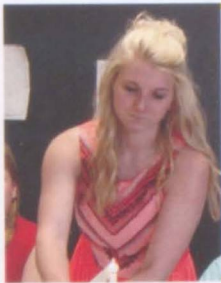
1. Noah Drummond helps out during the spring blood drive.

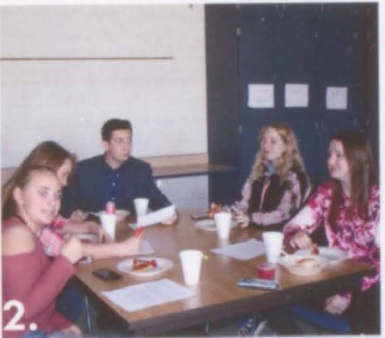


What is the main purpose of NHS and how do you fulfill the mission?
