

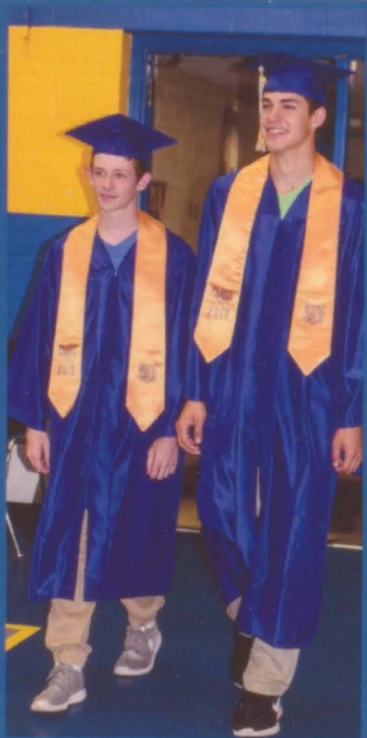
Above Left: Valedictorian Karah Brown gives her speech and explains the significance of her personalized graduation cap.
